Important Instructions for Presenters

Video Presentations Must Be Uploaded to Canvas by November 6, 2020 5pm:

Presentation and event set-up:

Your video and corresponding materials will be posted to Canvas in an area associated with your department. This will provide a dedicated space for attendees to view and engage in your research.

1. Navigate to the MLRW Canvas (you will be added upon registration through the submission portal)
2. Find the Module associated with your department
3. Scroll through the dropdown menu in that Module and locate the title of your submitted project (if you do not see your project listed under your department, please contact CSR/OOR?)

5. Be sure to check in daily and reply to any questions or comments the audience members post to your presentation.

The UCCS will be allowed to view the presentation videos, and read abstracts, while having the opportunity to comment on and discuss the research with the investigator(s) and UCCS community beginning at 8:30 a.m. on Monday, November 16, 2020.
