#### More Staff and Improved Processes

- Reorganized OSPRI to better serve campus needs into Office of Sponsored Programs and Office of Research Integrity
- Implemented 35 unique improvements to pre- and post-award processes, including a new PI handbook
- Welcomed two new members of OSP: A contract legal expert and a second pre-award specialist
- Updated the Guidelines and Procedures for Research Misconduct
- Revised the IRB Standard Operating Procedures



#### From Strategic Planning to Action

- First new Center established using the pitch processes the *Center for Research Frontiers in the Digital Humanities*
- Welcomed our first cohort of Rising Star Diversity Award grantees and expanded the program
- Awarded 33 COVID-19 Revitalization Fellowships
- Launched the Statistical Support Hub for faculty



#### **Expanding the Center for Student Research**



The mission of the Center for Student Research is to prepare and support undergraduate and graduate student researchers as well as their faculty mentors across disciplines. With over **370** student members and **80** faculty mentors, the CSR provides resources such as mentoring agreements, funding help, and hosting a variety of professional development workshops and creating toolkits. This year, the CSR increased the Director's effort, launching the new 12-member graduate student aspirational peer mentor network and the Write Now 5-week Graduate Writing Circle

- Enhancing research compliance with resources for NIH Data Management and Shared Policy and Other Support Disclosures

- Hosting evidence-based 5 week grant writing bootcamps, virtual bootcamps, offering workshops, and providing faculty and student travel funding
- Partnering with **Project CREST** to create inclusive RPT reviews, facilitate expanded pathways to full professor, clarify campus award nominations and create new reviewer instructions, and enhance our community building
