


UNDERSTANDING FACILITIES & ADMINISTRATIVE (F&A) FUNDING

When UCCS conducts sponsored programs, the sponsoring agency will fund the University for the expense of the project itself (direct costs) and facilities and administrative (F&A) costs. F&A costs are real costs incurred by the campus (human labor, infrastructure, and building utilities) which are associated with sponsored program activities. The sponsoring agency will publish the allowed F&A rate. UCCS has a federally negotiated F&A rate of 46%. You may have also heard F&A's being referred to as Indirect Cost Recovery or ICR, fortunately they are one in the same.
