New Research Travel Support Programs

The **Faculty Research Travel Supplemental Support Program** offers competitive funding to attend conferences (even virtual ones), archives, or visit research sites that will enhance their contribution to the institution and their students.

The **Undergraduate Research Travel Awards** offers funding on a rolling basis to support students presenting at peer-reviewed conferences (virtual conferences too!).



New Strategic Planning - Research Framework Initiative

Objectives:

- Use shared governance to define, advance, and implement the research framework by creating a transparent and responsive input process that informs all decision making.
- Create and implement campus-wide policies, practices, and evaluation metrics to clearly define, reward, and incentivize research and creative activity.
- Find ways to give faculty more time in their workload for research.
- Ensure accountability and bias-free implementation of research-related policies, incentives, and programs.



New Targeted Proposal Reviews in OSPRI

OSPRI now uses a targeted review process with a focus on budget and completeness. They will examine your budget excel file, budget justification, and check to ensure all required proposal components have been uploaded. Don't miss the five day deadline! Your budget and routing form can be completed well before your due date.



Continue building a strong culture of research

- Ensuring research and creative work could and can continue as much as possible during the pandemic.
- Sending out monthly **Office of Research Bulletin** detailing selected events, funding and award opportunities, and information that aims to support our campus' research and creative endeavors.
- Disseminating the **Celebration of Recent Research Achievements** - a list of recent faculty and student achievements in scholarship and sponsored programs.
- Awarded the very first UCCS **Research Mentoring Award**.
- Holding **Responsible Conduct of Research** Training Workshops (now remote!).
