The **Faculty Incentive Program (FIP)** encourages faculty to secure externally-funded sponsored programs by providing a process to receive a one-time, annual supplement to their salary using budgeted and available salary funds (e.g., an unused course buy-out).

The new **University Outstanding Research Mentorship Award** recognizes the extraordinary efforts by a faculty and/or staff member for providing outstanding research mentoring to UCCS students, staff, research associates, and/or faculty.



Updated Course Buy-out and Off-load Guidelines

- Provides a formula to calculate externally funded buy-out costs using workload allocation
- Standardizes internal buy-out costs
- Details off-load incentive for \$300,000 in external funding

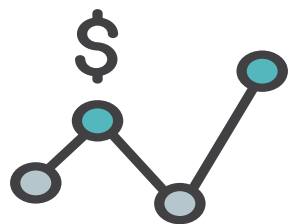
