Resources for Navigating Pandemic-era Evaluations

We partnered with the COVID-19 Faculty Assembly Task Force to collect resources, create guidance, and offer support to mitigate the pandemic's impact on researchers, especially women-identified, minority, and caregiving faculty. These include helpful tip sheets for writing the dossier, reviewer instructions for how to consider pandemic impacts in evaluation, and a new Revitalization Fellowship.

Growing the Center for Student Research

The mission of the CSR is to prepare and support undergraduate and graduate student researchers as well as their faculty mentors across disciplines. With over 300 student members, the CSR provides resources such as mentoring agreements, matching students with faculty, and hosting a variety of professional development workshops and toolkits. This year, the CSR began to set up an aspirational peer mentor network. The CSR implements the **Undergraduate Research Academy** and in 2022 had our largest cohort yet, with 33 student-faculty pairs.



Continue building a strong culture of research

- Sending out the monthly **Office of Research Bulletin** detailing selected events, funding and award opportunities, and information that aims to support our campus' research and creative endeavors
- Enhancing **Research Security Compliance** with a completed gap analysis and new research security "cookbook"
- Forging a new relationship with **Lewis Burke Associates** to assist with federal funding preparation
- Sharing campus research with the new **Distinguished Professor Lecture Series** and the **CRCW Awardee Talks**
- Pilot testing a process for an **Open Access Fund**
- OSPRI staff are now assisting with the registry as **ResearchMatch** liaisons
- Delivering **Responsible Conduct of Research** Training Workshops
- Hosting the evidence-based 5 week grant writing bootcamp, offering workshops, developing FAQs, and providing other professional development to meet the needs of our research community.
- Partnering with **Project CREST** to create inclusive annual reviews, promote research facilitation, enhance our community building, and make policy and process revisions

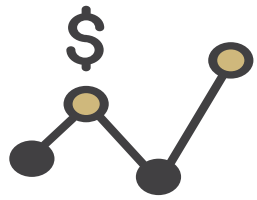

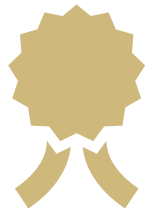
